MOSQUITOCON CONTEST RULES

1. Each registrant will be eligible for only one award per category (NO SWEEPS).
2. Models are entered solely at the entrants risk. NJIPMS, Wayne PAL, Judges, Modelers and IPMS/USA do not assume any liability for loss or damage to any model.
3. Models may be displayed on a base of reasonable size. Bases will not be judged in any category except Diorama. Any entry which, by virtue of its base or setting, depicts a story or a theme must be entered in the Diorama category.
4. Markings will be the sole determinant between the civil and military categories.
5. Contest Registration Committee will assist in determining an entries category at the time of registration; but, the final determination rests with the Chief Judge. The decisions of the Chief Judge are Final. Categories may be combined or split at the judges' discretion.

6. Junior entrants (age 17 or younger) may compete in either the junior or regular categories, or both.
7. "Out of the Box" Award will be governed by standard IPMS rules: other decal's ok; filling of seams and gaps; drilling of gun ports and exhausts; thin to scale trailing edges, flaps and doors, all ok; antennae and rigging ok. Tape or decal seat belts ok. No other added items are permitted. Kit instruction sheets must be displayed with model to qualify for the "Out of the Box" award.
8. Major conversions must be a substantial reworking of the model to a different version. Commercial conversions are a separate category.
9. Vacuform category is reserved for those models which were constructed from a kit. At least 60% of the kit must be vacuformed and most major structures must be vacuformed.
10. Any odd scale entries will be placed with the closest scale (i.e., 1/50 may be placed with 1/48; 1/76 with 1/72, etc.) at judges' discretion.
11. The Best Civilian Subject Award must be a non-military subject to qualify. Models can be a subject of military origins in civilian markings, i.e. a P-51 displayed as an air racer or an IL-76 in Aeroflot markings. Markings must be authentic and reference or documentation material must be available.
12. Any attempt to influence the judges in any way will result in all of the modeler's entries being disqualified.
13. Models that have won at an IPMS Regional prior to April 2009, or any previous Mosquitocon, or IPMS USA National will not be eligible.
14. 3 models of different classes grouped and displayed as a single entry. The models will be judged as a group, with overall quality determining placement. Credit will be given for diversity of entries. Entries must be composed of 3 models selected from 3 of different categories (I.E., 1/700 Battleship, 1/48th aircraft, 1/35th armor). No more than 1 of the 3 models constituting an entry may have won as an individual entry in a previous contest.
15. Figures Category Classifications to be determined on the day of the contest.
16. Award for the Best "1940-England Stands Alone" theme is open to any category entrant, military, civilian, or otherwise. Entrant's are encouraged to display references and documentation with the model, proving the entries' strong tie to the theme—it could be the deciding factor.

DIRECTIONS TO MOSQUITOCON 2010

Coming from the East (New York, Long Island, NJ Turnpike): Take 80 West to Exit 53 to Rt. 23 North Wayne/Butler/Verona to Exit South 202 (signals reads, Alt. 511, Lincoln Park/Boonton exit 1/2 mile.) at end of exit South 202 stay to left, and make left at top sign, first street (Taylor Drive) make right, go to end of street. Make right onto PAL Drive. Look for PAL on right hand side of street.

Coming from the West (Pennsylvania): Take 80 East to Exit 53 to Rt. 46 East. (sign reads, Wayne/Clifton/Lincoln Tunnel) Go to first or second overpass and make a "U-Turn" onto 46 west. Stay to right and look for signs for 23 North. Take 23 North to Exit South 202, at end of exit South 202, stay to left and make left at stop sign, first street (Taylor Dr.) make right, go to end of street. Make right onto PAL Drive. Wayne PAL is on the right side.
